IDEA

WHY A SUMMER CAMP IN POLAND?

Summer camps in Poland are not only a holiday break, but also a wise investment in language, identity, and relationships—elements that are especially important for children growing up abroad. They are also a symbolic return to the childhood of parents or grandparents—a time of carefree freedom and simple joys.

During the trip, children immerse themselves in the atmosphere of old-fashioned holidays: full of backyard creativity, shared games, and discovering the world together. We combine what today's children love with games familiar from their parents' youth, creating a space where generations meet through shared experiences and traditions are passed on in a light and joyful way.

Summer camps in Poland are also a space of genuine freedom that young people often need: freedom from rush, overstimulation, screens, and everyday duties. By accompanying them through their summer rest, we give them the chance to breathe in the fullness of summer—to explore, create, and build relationships.

Contact with Polish culture in a natural, everyday environment strengthens a sense of belonging, deepens the bond with Polish heritage, and helps children better understand their bilingual identity. Such experiences foster friendships, support the development of important skills, and allow young people to reconnect with their family roots.

CAMP DETAILS



WE PROVIDE:

- organisation of a holiday stay from 18–26 July 2026,
- accommodation at the fantastic Ośrodek Bolko in Bolesławów (the Kłodzko Valley - Kotlina Kłodzka),
- a large recreational area in the heart of nature, providing plenty of space for sports and team-building activities,
- tasty and healthy meals tailored to the participants' active daily schedule, five trips (a gold mine and historic mining settlements, Błędne Skały, Jaskinia Niedźwiedzia, Czarna Góra, Wrocław),
- an individual support programme focused on developing Polish language skills and strengthening the child's relationship with broadly understood Polish heritage and culture,
- activities that build on children's strengths, with time included for rest and recovery,
- care provided by a qualified team specialising in working with bilingual children,
- the opportunity to build friendships with Polish-diaspora peers from all over the world,
- projects inspiring children to draw strength and benefits from their heritage,
- additional support from an educator, speech therapist, and child psychologist,
- personal accident insurance (NNW).

Cost of the camp:
PLN 3,760

The price includes:

- care provided by a qualified team specialising in working with bilingual children (including: camp director, camp counsellor, sports programme coordinator, psychologist, educator, speech therapist, and a teacher of Polish as a foreign language),
- accommodation at the Ośrodek Bolko in Stronie Śląskie, in rooms offering comfort, safety, and good conditions for rest,
- tasty and healthy meals tailored to the participants' active daily schedule,
- participation in five unique trips, during which children will discover the region's most beautiful places (a gold mine and historic mining settlements, Błędné Skały, Jaskinia Niedźwiedzia, Czarna Góra, Wrocław),
- inspiring themed activities that develop language, teach cooperation and relationship-building, and strengthen emotional confidence,
- team-building activities and special events (including: a campfire and outdoor mission games),
- a complete package of materials, creative kits, and professional sports equipment, ensuring top-quality sessions,
